The mandate of Ubuntu Football is to mentor and educate the next generation of great African leaders, society-changers and footballers.

Our vision is:

- to be the leading football development program in Africa
- to invest holistically in talented young footballers in a long-term context, enabling them to reach their full potential both on the football pitch and as men of excellent character

What is Ubuntu?

Ubuntu (oo-boon-too) is an African expression of togetherness. It means that what I am is intrinsically linked to and part of what we are. Nowhere is this idea of human synergy more perfectly expressed than on a sports field where a group of individuals rise or fall together depending on the presence or absence of that intangible alchemy, melding individuals into one seamless unit. How we work - Our Strategy

Football Forward and Skills School:

This initiative is how we identify potential talent for our academy. Through scouting and open trials we are able to identify high potential players. On Fridays we offer our official Football Forward for these players. They receive professional training, character building and we build a strong relationship with their families whilst grooming the under 12's for the opportunity to be in our academy.

On Mondays and Wednesdays we facilitate our Skills School as our community engagement program in for locations around the city. This a give back and income generation tactic. A typical session involves learning a new skill, participating in a devotion, and then enjoying more than an hour of 5-a-side play. We use this program to meet kids and help develop and mentor them from a young age.

Ubuntu Football Academy:

Each year we add 8 to 12 of our Football Forward players to the Academy through a process of intensive trials and scouting. Our academy includes: daily professional football training, Grade 7-12 education at our private, independent school, mentorship and leadership training and a loving residence for students who live far away or in hostile home situations. During these years we focus on their holistic development on the field, academically, and emotionally as well as assist with their future career planning and pathways. Most graduates, depending on their skill set and exposure, have the option of playing football professionally (locally and internationally), studying in the US on a football bursary, or studying locally and finding an internship/job.

Graduates:

We have a close knit relationship with most of our alumni (since 2015) and continue to keep a mentorship relationship where possible. Since our mandate is holistic, we want to see our boys continue to live out the Ubuntu values and bring positive change in all their spheres of influence.
